EXHIBITION

DEVEX 2010 will incorporate an exhibition within the catering area to encourage maximum interaction between exhibitors and delegates during the poster and exhibition sessions as well as during all breaks. It is expected that in excess of 400 delegates will attend.

- The exhibition spaces are arranged in single units (3m x 2m), but two or more adjacent units can be combined to make a larger space. Please refer to the DEVEX 2010 Exhibition Floor Plan to make your selection.
- Each space is 3m wide and 2m deep and is suitable for a pop-up portable display stand or tabletop display.
- Each space is made up of hard walled shell scheme (suitable to fix posters to with Velcro) and includes:
 - 3m by 2m shell scheme walls
 - 1 x trestle style table
 - 2 x chairs
 - 1 x standard UK power outlet (240v/500 watt)
 - 2 x spotlights
 - Name Board
 - Carpet (standard colour throughout Exhibition Hall)
- Space only stands can also be booked, and will include 1 x standard UK power outlet (240v) and carpet (standard colour throughout Exhibition Hall)
- No wired Internet access or phone lines will be available as standard on the stands, however, AECC is a Wireless LAN venue and Internet access can be purchased.
